For it to be so cold outside the smiles that filled this room kept us all warm.

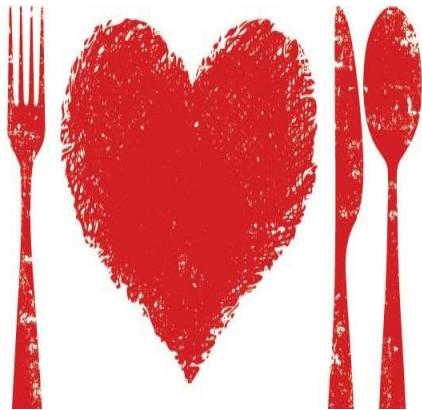

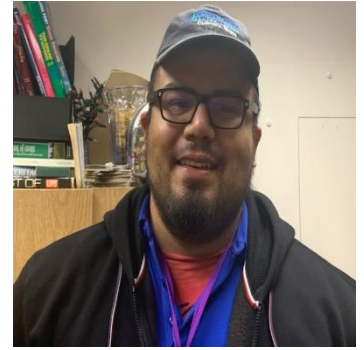
