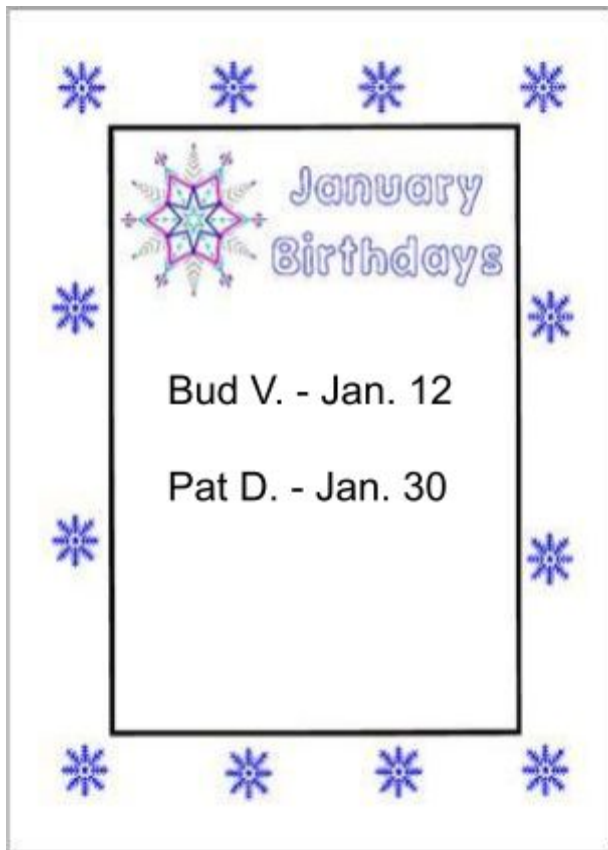
What To Expect This Month..

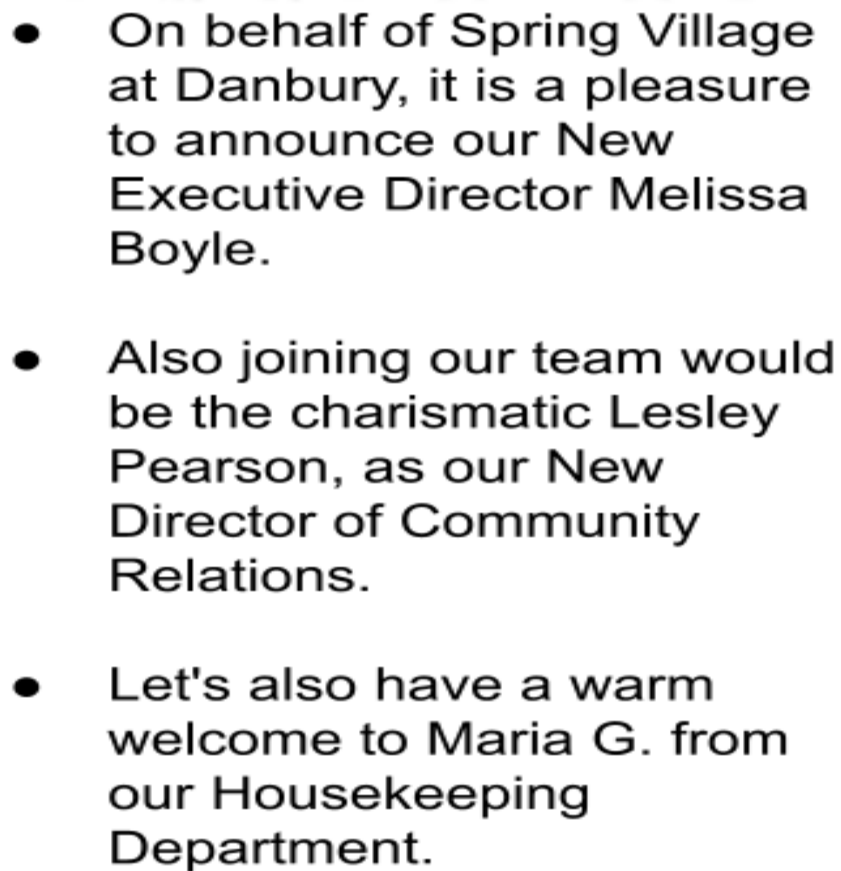


Spring Village Book Club
